Wrapping and disposing of toxic waste

Toxic waste management

Description:

Toxic waste disposal or hazardous waste is essential for a proper disposal to minimize the environmental contamination. There are 2 disposal methods as follows:

Type 1: Chemical waste in the laboratory: each laboratory in university and nearby schools is equipped with chemical waste disposal system to ensure correct disposal. The waste is taken to waste storage area at Science and Applied Science Center. The private companies responsible for disposal are notified and provide reports to ensure compliance with safety protocols for each laboratory.

Type 2: electronic waste such as electronic devices, light bulbs, spray cans and batteries, is handled by local authorities.
